The City of Appleton will accept donations of any unsold items from the Rummage Sale and donate them to Goodwill. Food and drink will be available at the event.

Once they have been filled, a waiting list will be started. Registration deadline is Monday, July 16th. **Come and join the fun, this event is free and open to the public!**

### Things to keep in mind prior to the Rummage Sale:

- Tables reserved will be limited to one per family. Each vendor will receive one park picnic table to display their items. Items may be displayed on table tops and seats. Please keep area in front of table clear. **IF YOU DON'T SHOW FOR YOUR TABLE, YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED THE FOLLOWING YEAR!**
- Each table must provide their own change, starter money, and a calculator.
- This event is for kids! Parents should encourage their child to participate in all of the communication with customers and in the sale of items and offer support when needed.
- Youth ages 12 and under must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- All prices marked are final! Please do not try and talk the prices down.
- The sale of food, beverages or any merchandise other than items for the rummage sale is strictly prohibited.
- Participants should plan on staying at their table for the entire event. Please do not leave your table unattended at any time.
- If you have reserved a table, please arrive no later than 8:30 a.m. to check-in and set-up
- Per City of Appleton Ordinance, no pets are allowed in the park.
- Food and drink will be available at the park.
- First aid will be available at the check-in station.
- This event will be held outdoors. In the event of rain, the event will move under the pavilion.
- Electrical hook ups are not available.
- Vendors may want to bring batteries to demonstrate that certain games and toys are in working condition.
