GAME DATES: June 12 – August 2 (no games the week of July 3).

GAME TIMES: Leagues play once per week – See reverse side for scheduled nights.

- Youngest ages play first each night (as early as 5:00pm)
- Older ages may play later games. (all games complete by 9pm).

PRACTICES: Practices begin week of May 29, and are scheduled by the volunteer coach.

See the registration form (over) for specific information pertaining to each league. All players will be contacted by their volunteer coach following the Coaches Meeting in mid/late May with information about practice and game times. Parents and children will be required to co-sign a concussion information acknowledgment prior to the start of team activities. This form will be sent to all registered families by email, along with preliminary league details and information, once team rosters have been completed (mid May).
