



RUMMAGE SALE

Join us at Pierce Park on Tuesday, July 27th from 9:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. for the 8th Annual Kids Rummage Sale! Youth ages 5-17 may reserve a space to sell gently used toys, games, clothes, and accessories while learning how to interact with people and conduct the sale of goods, plus you keep the profits! The City of Appleton will accept donations of any unsold items from the Rummage Sale and donate them to Goodwill.

Registration for this event will be online at www.appletonparkandrec.org. 30 tables will be available on a first come, first serve basis. Once they have been filled, a waiting list will be started. Registration deadline is Monday, July 12th. **Come and join the fun, this event is free and open to the public!**

Things to keep in mind prior to the Rummage Sale:

- Tables reserved will be limited to one per family. Each vendor will receive one park picnic table to display their items. Items may be displayed on tabletops and seats. Please keep area in front of table clear. **IF YOU DON'T SHOW FOR YOUR TABLE, YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED THE FOLLOWING YEAR!**
- You will need to haul your items from the parking lot to the pavilion. We will have limited carts available to help make this process easier.
- Each table must provide their own change, starter money, and a calculator.
- This event is for kids! Parents should encourage their child to participate in all the communication with customers and in the sale of items and offer support when needed.
- Youth ages 12 and under must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- All prices marked are final! Please do not try and talk the prices down.
- The sale of food, beverages, or any merchandise other than items for the rummage sale is strictly prohibited.
- Participants should plan on staying at their table for the entire event. Please do not leave your table unattended at any time.
- Participants may begin to check-in starting at 8:00 a.m. on the 27th.
- First aid will be available at the check-in station.
- The event will be held under the pavilion at Pierce Park.
- Electrical hook ups are not available.
- Vendors may want to bring batteries to demonstrate that certain games and toys are in working condition.
